### **Terms of Reference:**

The purpose of the Research Portfolio Management Committee is to integrate the academic and administrative activities of the portfolio and to advise the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine in relation to research strategy and initiatives, and to support and promote research and research training in the Faculty of Medicine.

It will do this by, in consultation with the Faculty of Medicine's Research Committee and the Dean's Advisory Group, developing policies and initiatives on research strategy for the Faculty.

It will also participate in debate on research strategy at the University level through the DVCR's Research Strategy Committee and advise the Dean in relation to these matters.

This Committee will develop policy and initiatives and communicate issues to the Dean's Advisory Group in the following areas:

- People and training
- Infrastructure and capital development
- Performance/effectiveness
- Support – funding schemes (internal and external) and management systems
- Research students - oversight of the academic and administrative processes relating to postgraduate research student candidatures.
- Community - engagement, visibility
- Development of strategy (the next Strategic Plan).

**Frequency:** every 4 weeks.
