Why?

These two separate seminars will provide forums for university faculty members and healthcare professionals to examine ways we can improve the quality of healthcare in Timor-Leste through education, medical expertise and resources.

Keynote speaker: Dr. Dan Murphy, founder of the Bairo Pite Clinic in Dili.

This under resourced clinic sees up to 500 patients per day, treating patients with diseases such as malaria, tuberculosis, dengue fever, and post-traumatic stress disorder, while also providing comprehensive community health services. Dr. Murphy will discuss the serious health issues facing the Timorese and the need for medical and educational resources.
